To Whom It May Concern,

TLC Diversified, Inc. was hired by the Martin County Utilities & Solid Waste Department to remove and replace two (2) 4,150 gallon sulfuric acid tanks at the Tropical Farms Water Treatment Plant.

The two (2) existing sulfuric acid tanks that were set to be removed were drained, sulfuric acid from the tanks were transferred to other sulfuric acid tanks on site, and any residual chemical was neutralized. On April 15, 2019 the Marin County Operations team took a sample of the small amount of remaining liquid in the tanks and confirmed that the solution on the tank is near neutral ph.

TLC Diversified has been hired by the Martin County Utilities & Solid Waste Department and can address specific measures that were taken to ensure the tanks are safe for transport and disposal.
