Dive into fun at Sailfish Splash Waterpark this spring break

Sailfish Splash Waterpark will open its gates for its seventh season on Saturday, March 10, 2018 for Martin County and St. Lucie County's Spring Break week. After March 18, Sailfish Splash will be open weekends leading up to their grand summer opening on May 26.

Martin County's premiere destination for family fun boasts:

- 1,000- foot lazy river
- two 4-story water slides including a 253 foot enclosed flume "Speed Slide"
- 7,326 square foot interactive splash playground with jets, sprays, slides and a 317-gallon "Dump Bucket"
- "Wiggly Waters" cargo net walk-across obstacle course

Sailfish Splash Waterpark also offers shaded picnic areas, 700 lounge and deck chairs, a gift shop, snack bar, private cabanas for rent and free WiFi.

The venue also serves as the Treasure Coast's hub for diverse and beneficial aquatic athletics and recreation, including a full curriculum of swimming lessons, lifeguard training, a kids triathlon, competitive swimming and diving teams, scuba diving instruction, synchronized swimming, the World's Largest Swim Lesson, inner tube water polo, teen nights, and year-round lap/fitness swimming.

Sailfish Splash Waterpark's Aquatic Center was recently selected to host the Florida High School Athletic Association's (FHSAA) Florida High School Swimming & Diving State Championships creating substantial economic impact for Martin County.

Walk-up day admission is \$14.95 for adults and \$12.95 for kids and seniors, and season passes cost \$84.00 for adults and \$72.00 for kids and seniors. Season Passes include a variety of benefits including early admission and discounts at Sailfish Splash and Martin County Golf Course.
